DAY ONE - SUNDAY Arrive at Rogue Valley International Airport, Medford, Oregon. Shuttle Service to Ashland. Enjoy an evening at the [Oregon Shakespeare Festival](#) and lodging at [Ashland Springs Hotel](#).

DAY TWO - MONDAY Enjoy the day at [Crater Lake National Park](#), local cuisine at [Summer Jo's](#), and lodging at the historic [Weasku Inn](#) in Grants Pass.

DAY THREE - TUESDAY Your Rogue River Adventure begins. Hike 9.3 miles with lunch served trailside. This evening relax with appetizers, dinner, and comfortable accommodations at [Black Bar Lodge](#).

DAY FOUR - WEDNESDAY After a hearty breakfast at the lodge continue on the Rogue River Trail for a 14 mile trek. Lunch will be served trailside and tonight's dinner and lodging will be at [Marial Lodge](#). Be prepared for a fun evening!

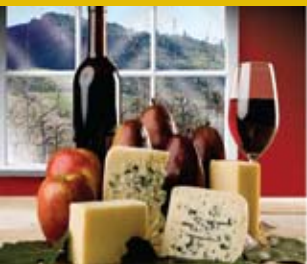
DAY FIVE - THURSDAY Today is an easy 5 mile hiking exploration. Hike up trail to Rogue River Ranch and visit museum. Hike down river to the [Paradise Lodge](#) and enjoy lunch on the deck, and a relaxing evening at one of the nation's most remote lodges. Small hikes are available, or read a book in a hammock, take a nap or swim in the creek.

DAY SIX - FRIDAY On the trail for your final 10 mile hike. Lunch at beautiful [Flora Dell Falls](#). Back to civilization. Arrive at the five star [Tu Tu Tun Lodge](#) near Gold Beach for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY SEVEN - SATURDAY Rejoin your driver and head for Hwy 101 to Crescent City, California to visit and hike in [Redwood National Park](#). Lodging in Grants Pass at [The Lodge at Riverside](#).

DAY EIGHT - SUNDAY What better way to end your trip than a visit to [Wildlife Images](#), wine tasting in the [Applegate Valley](#), and a farewell dinner in Jacksonville at the famed [Jacksonville Inn](#).

DAY NINE - MONDAY Depart Jacksonville, via your private shuttle, to the [Rogue Valley International Airport](#) just a short 15 minutes from Jacksonville.
